- Squirrel Cove operation review
 - Review of correspondence from local community regarding upcoming harvest
 - In-depth discussion addressing individual points and clarifying facts with current and past management
 - Balancing support of local economic activity, good use of existing infrastructure, consideration of eco-system impacts and local community concerns
 - Decision to fulfill current orders with no additional trees cut for firewoodonly purposes. Firewood available will be from waste only.
 - Commitment to light touch, single-stem selection along SQ4 roadway
 - Buyers will purchase whole trees to 6" top to maximize use of each tree and minimize number of trees cut
 - Recognition of benefit of 2 smaller harvest to fulfill needs of local mills
 - Letter to be posted answering community concerns
 - Draft contract for roadbuilding reviewed and approved
- 2017 budget review and approval
 - Mark brought projected budget for 2017
 - Profit sharing discussed and approved for disbursement in March 2017.
 - 2017 General Operations numbers approved with modifications:
 - Separate silviculture account to be opened, cage costs to be included
 - Directors declined stipend
 - Minute-taking stipend to be paid in compensation for minute-taking,
 circulation and posting to the website at a rate of \$100.00/board meeting
- Miscellaneous
 - J. Marlow resignation as consulting RPF
 - John offered his resignation from further formal work for the CFGP
 - All management files transferred to Mark
 - Our thanks for John's experience and expertise in these first challenging years of the Community Forest
 - Letter suggesting upgrade to fish box in Larsen's Meadow received. Further details required. Written proposal requested by Board.

- 6. Mark to send reminder invoices to commercial firewood cutters for 2016 orders. \$800.00/logging truck load & \$25.00/cord.
- 7. Mark to contact Colleen to confirm year end results reporting and any on-going services.
- 8. Mark to have regeneration survey completed by certified silviculturalist by May 31, 2018.
- 9. Mark will R.S.V.P. to attend first LEAP meeting.
