



CFGP Safe Work Procedures and Policies

Policy for Notification to Members of the Public Prior to Operations:

Prior to the start-up of falling right-of-way, road construction, falling, bucking and yarding of cutblocks and hauling, the CFGP will ensure the following methods of communication are undertaken to notify neighbours and members of the public when operations are near or adjacent to public roads and private property:

1. Signs will be posted at any road entrance to the operation
2. An email and/or phone call will be sent to immediate neighbours notifying of operations start-up date and approximate length of operation.
3. A notice will be posted online to the CFGP Website and updated regularly
